

**'The two Gregories: Nyssen and Nazianzen'**

Basil of Caesarea has become the dominant point of reference for both his brother Gregory of Nyssa and his friend Gregory of Nazianzus. However, the other line of the Cappadocian triangle is also a substantial and significant one. This paper will consider the letters that survive from Gregory Nazianzen to Gregory Nyssen, and the oration that he addresses to him, and will suggest that the relationship was a more significant and more complex one than has been recognized.
